*American Refugee* may be the last history book you'll ever read as it defines the dark force that throughout time has brought down man's most formidable social creations but has not quite, not yet, defeated America, because of what the nation did *before* 1960 and despite what it has done since

English author Leonard Bolton in *American Refugee* describes the historical phenomenon that destroyed the Roman Empire in the fifth century and arrived in the United States in the 1960s, bringing with it questionable changes that became critical in 2008. In assessing how civilizations decline via their participants, Bolton ticks off the current manifestations of this historical phenomenon: budget deficits, litigation, higher crime rates, serial killers, schoolyard shootings, divorce, persistent poverty, exported jobs, weird jury decisions, and the death of personal responsibility.

Bolton argues that this dark force, this unseen phase he calls Phase B, brings classical periods to an end. In the case of America, he hones in on the spiritual and mental differences between the GIs of World War II and their baby boomers as he takes into account crime, politics, justice, economics, education, and personal relationships. As he says, "Those generations created two very different worlds."

On the other hand, Bolton applauds what he calls "a rare interlude of a genuine Camelot when founding Americans (Phase A Americans) revolted, threw off colonial rule, resisted central banking, separated church and state, eschewed the international socialist delusion, and most of all – separated economy and state."

With keen and comprehensive detail, *American Refugee* provides an external view of the United States that has perspectives invisible to the average American, without which history wouldn't make sense.
